

The General Practice Immunisation Incentives Report GP11020A

- Released quarterly by the Australian Childhood Immunisation Register (ACIR) to those practices who are registered for the GP11 scheme and have requested the report.
- Provides details of children in your practices assessed by the ACIR as not fully immunised.
- Indicates those children for whom the ACIR does not have a completed and accurate record of their vaccination status, which will affect the level of immunisation coverage for the practice and therefore outcomes payments received every quarter.
- The report should be requested by all practices and attended to each quarter by a designated member of staff.

Information available in the Report includes:

- The most current immunisation data recorded on the Immunisation Register for each child listed, as at the time of the report being generated.
- Identifies vaccines required to be recorded on the Immunisation Register in order for the child to be fully immunised.

Benefits of Using the Report

If information is provided to the Immunisation Register before the next quarter, it can be included in the re-calculation, which may increase the practice's coverage rate and benefit the Practice by an adjustment in the Outcomes payment for that quarter.

Accessing the Report

The GP11 Practice report can be requested and produced via the ACIR Internet site at http://www.medicareaustralia.gov.au/providers/programs_services/acir/index.htm. A GP must first request access to the secured area.

GPs without secure Internet access can complete a *GP11 Practice Report Request* form, or phone 1800 246 101 and request a copy.

What to do with the report?

When you obtain this report, you should review the information on the report against the information in your medical records. If the words “not fully immunised” appear next to “assessment status”, the following may provide reasons why and directions to take:

- A)** Children you have immunised but have not reported to the ACIR, or ACIR have not received the encounter forms or processed them:
 - ↳ make the adjustments on the report and send back to the ACIR
- B)** Children who have attended your practice and are actually due/overdue for a vaccination:
 - ↳ identify, contact patient, immunise, and notify the ACIR immediately
- C)** Children who have been immunised by another provider
 - ↳ notify ACIR on History Form (IMMU 13)
