

## Making Adjustments to the GPII Practice Report (GPII020A)

The easiest way of correcting a child's history according to the GPII Practice Report (GPII020A report) is to make the adjustments on the report and send/fax to either:

### Adjustments to make:

- Add information on missing vaccine/s, dose, date given, and the immunising provider number, from your medical records
- Add information on vaccinations done by other providers using the Blue Book

Place a practice stamp on each child's record that requires adjustments to be made. Make it clear who the provider of the immunisation is and get the provider to initial the adjustments.

### On the cover letter or fax cover page write:

*“Corrections to the ACIR based on the GPII Practice Report – please attend to adjustments. Thank you”*

This method of correcting a child's history will generate a payment if required.
